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1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
2. If the bidder is a Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
3. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for % (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 [OM_No.1_4_2021_PPD_dated_18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent applicator of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.
4. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions/क्रेता द्वारा जोड़ी गई बिड की विशेष शर्तें**1. Generic**

OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration

2. Certificates

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

3. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

(I) Special Conditions of Contract (SCC):-

(1) Liquidated Damages: If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or fails to perform the services within the time frame(s) incorporated in the contract, SPMCIL shall, without prejudice to other rights and remedies available to SPMCIL under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as liquidated damages, a sum equivalent to the ½% percent (or any other percentage if prescribed in the SCC) of the delivered price of the delayed goods and/ or services for each week of delay or part thereof until actual delivery or performance subject to a maximum deduction of the 10% (or any other percentage if prescribed in the SCC) of the delayed goods' or services' contract price(s). During the above-mentioned delayed period of supply and / or performance, the conditions incorporated under GCC sub-clause 23.4 shall also apply. In all such cases GST would also be applicable on LD.

(2) Risk Purchase: If the bidder after submission of bid and due acceptance of the same i.e. after issue of Contract Order fails to abide by the terms and conditions of these bid documents, or fails to supply the deliverables/provide services as per delivery schedule given or at any time repudiates the contract, the purchaser shall have the right to:

i: Invoke the Security-cum-Performance Guarantee if deposited by the bidder and procure stores/services from other agencies at the risk and consequence of the supplier. The cost difference between the alternative arrangement and supplier tendered value will be recovered from the supplier along with other incidental charges, including taxes, insurance etc.

In case of procurement through alternative sources and if procurement price is lower, no benefit on this account will be passed onto the supplier.

(3) Tender cancellation: The Chief General Manager, Security Printing Press, Hyderabad, India reserves the right to accept in part or in full any tender or reject any tender without assigning any reason or to cancel the tendering process and reject all tenders at any time prior to award of contract, without incurring any liability, whatsoever to the affected tenderer or tenderers.

(4) Termination of Contract: Security Printing Press, Hyderabad reserves the right to terminate the contract at any stage by giving one week's notice. No claim whatsoever shall lie against the SPMCIL on account of such termination of the contract or variation in the quantity.

(5) Cancellation of Contract for Default: Without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, like removal from the list of registered supplier, by written notice of default sent to the supplier, the contract may be terminated in whole or in part:

(i) If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the stores within the time period(s) specified in the contract, or any extension thereof granted.

(ii) If the supplier fails to perform any other obligation under the contract within the period specified in the contract or any extension thereof granted.

(6) Termination of Contract for Convenience: After placement of contract, there may be some unforeseen situation compelling SPMCIL to cancel the contract. In such a case, a suitable notice is to be sent to the supplier for cancellation of the contract, in whole or in part, for its (SPMCIL's) convenience, inter alia, indicating the date with effect from which the termination is to become effective. Depending on the merits of the case, the supplier may have to be suitably compensated on mutually agreed terms for terminating the contract. Suitable provisions to this effect are to be incorporated in the tender document as well as in the resultant contract.

(7) Resolution of Disputes: Contractual disputes for resolution through arbitration to the India International Arbitration Centre (IIAC), New Delhi.

(8) Price Adjustment Clause: No Price Adjustment allowed.

(9) No conditional bids will be accepted.

(II) Delivery Schedule:-

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Schedule 1:-

PreAudit, Final Audit & Certification of ISO 14298:2021:- It includes Registration fees, Adequacy Audit/Stage 1 review fees, Initial Audit/Stage 2 review fees & Certification Fees (issue of certification).

The above work must be completed within 30 days after placement of the Contract Order.

Schedule 2:-

Surveillance Audit after 1 Year:- Review of documentation & Implementation, including audit fees.

The above work must be completed after 1 year from the date of Certification.

Schedule 3:-

Surveillance Audit after 2 Year:- Review of documentation & Implementation, including audit fees.

The above work must be completed after 2 years from the date of Certification.

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Note:

If at any time during the currency of the contract, the supplier encounters conditions hindering timely performance of services, the supplier shall promptly inform SPP, Hyderabad in writing about the same and its likely duration and make a request SPP, Hyderabad for extension of the delivery schedule accordingly. On receiving the supplier's communication, SPP, Hyderabad shall examine the situation as soon as possible and, at its discretion, may agree to extend the delivery schedule, with or without liquidated damages for completion of supplier's contractual obligations by issuing an amendment to the contract.

(III) Quality Control Requirements:-

The services will be accepted strictly as per Scope of Work provided in the bid document. If any defects are observed or the material / service found unsuitable, then the same will be rejected and replaced at supplier's / Service Provider's own risk and cost.

(IV) Qualification/Eligibility Criteria:-

The Bidder firm must be capable to provide relevant services as per the scope of work.

(V) Checklist:- The bidder has to submit the following documents with authorized seal and signatory of the firm:-

5	Undertaking/Declaration	The firm should submit undertaking that “the information given in the documents are correct and the Bidder is aware that in case any information provided is found to be false at a later stage, SPP reserves the right to reject/disqualify the bidder at any stage of the tendering process without assigning any reason.”
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Note:-

Bidders have to furnish stipulated documents in support of fulfillment of Eligibility Criteria. Decision on finalization of bid will be taken based on the documents submitted along with the bid. All above documents must be submitted as per bid requirement failing which offers will be liable for rejection and no further correspondence will be made/ entertained for clarifications after opening of the bid. It may be noted that the price is not to be quoted in Technical bid. It shall only be quoted in Price bid. Non-adherence to this shall make bid liable for rejection.

(VI) Additional documents:-

In addition to above, the bidder has to submit the below documents also:-

(VI) The terms and conditions, guidelines of SPMCIL Procurement Manual Version 3.0 will be applicable to this bid at any stage to avoid any conflict at later stage. Kindly refer GIT and GCC of SPMCIL Procurement Manual Version 3.0 for additional terms and conditions as per links given below:-

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(VII) Conditions for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs):-

(1) As per Public Procurement Policy (PPP) for Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 issued vide Gazette Notification dated 23.03.2012 by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises of Gov. of India, MSEs must be registered with any of the following in order to avail the benefits / preference available vide Public Procurement Policy MSEs Order, 2012.

- a) District Industries Centers (DIC)
- b) Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC)
- c) Khadi and Village Industries Board
- d) Coir Board
- e) National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC)
- f) Directorate of Handicraft and Handloom
- g) Any other body specified by Ministry of MSME (MoMSME)
- h) Udyog Aadhaar Acknowledgment / Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum issued by MoMSME.

(2) MSEs participating in the tender must submit valid & authorized copy of certificate of registration with any one of the above agencies. In case of bidders submitting DIC registration certificate shall attach original notarised copy of the DIC certificate. The MSE's Bidder to note and ensure that nature of services and goods / items manufactured mentioned in MSEs certificate matches with the nature of the services and goods / items to be supplied as per Tender or otherwise exemption cannot be granted.

(3) Traders / resellers / distributors / authorized agents will not be considered for availing benefits under PPP Policy 2012 for MSEs as per MSE guidelines issued by MoMSME.

(4) The registration certificate issued from any one of the above agencies must be valid as on Bid closing date of the tender. Bidder shall ensure validity of registration certificate in case bid closing date is extended.

(5) The MSEs who have applied for registration or renewal of registration with any of the above agencies / bodies, but have not obtained the valid certificate as on close date of the tender, are not eligible for exemption / preference.

(6) Relaxation of Norms for Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs): Pre-qualification criteria with respect to Prior Turnover and Prior experience is relaxed for Micro & Small Enterprises as per GOI guidelines subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications/Scope of work.

(VIII) Conditions for Start-Up Companies:-

(1) Start-up Enterprises: Requirements of prior experience and turnover would be relaxed for Start-up enterprises as recognised by Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), subject to their meeting the quality and technical specifications. Such Start-ups may be either MSE or otherwise.

(2) Subject to meeting of Quality and Technical Specifications, SPP may consider allowing the participation of "Start up" companies with capability to execute the supply / services, as per technical specifications / perform the job as per scope of work specified in the tender and subject to meeting extant & relevant guidelines of Government of India. This should be confirmed and substantiated in the technical bid.

(3) The bidder who intends to participate as "Start up" company should enclose the Certificate of Recognition issued by Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Govt. of India during submission of Technical bid.

(4) Pre-qualification criteria with respect to Prior Turnover and Prior experience is relaxed for Start up Enterprises as per GOI guidelines subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications.

(5) However, there may be circumstances like procurement of items / services related to public safety, health critical security operations and equipment, etc wherein SPP reserves the right to not consider relaxation of Prior Turnover and Prior Experience for Start up Companies as per GOI guidelines.

(6) Start up Companies who are also registered as MSEs and wish to avail the benefits as applicable to MSE, shall submit relevant documents covered under Conditions for Micro and Small Enterprises elsewhere in this tender.

4. **Generic**

Manufacturer Authorization: Wherever Authorised Distributors/service providers are submitting the bid, Authorisation Form /Certificate with OEM/Original Service Provider details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid

Disclaimer/अस्वीकरण

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.

3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

This Bid is governed by the [General Terms and Conditions/सामान्य नियम और शर्तें](#), conditions stipulated in Bid and [Service Level Agreement](#) specific to this Service as provided in the Marketplace. However in case if any condition specified in General Terms and Conditions/सामान्य नियम और शर्तें is contradicted by the conditions stipulated in Service Level Agreement, then it will over ride the conditions in the General Terms and Conditions.

In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which share a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority.
